When do antibiotics help?

Antibiotics have no effect in the case of

mild tonsillitis colds bronchitis ordinary coughing

Have doubtful effect in the case of

ear infections in children aged between 1-12 years sinus infections

Can alleviate symptoms in the case of tonsillitis cystitis

Can reduce the risk of complications in the case of

ear infections in infants certain wound infections

Must be used in the case of

borrelia chlamydia and gonorrhoea



They save lives in the case of blood poisoning meningitis pneumonia pyelonephritis
